Brick job builds on top project

HENRY HENDERSON has a full-time job thanks to his hard work and an award-winning partnership between business and the community.

The Midland 23-year-old works full-time at Midland Brick after taking part in an employment project that the company runs in conjunction with the Hills Community Support Group.

The project has won the firm and group the Prime Minister's Community Business Partnership award in the WA large business category.

The partnership will be judged against winners from other States and Territories for a \$10,000 national prize next month.

Presenting the award, WA Senator Alan Eggleston said the employment program gave local youths an opportunity to enter the workforce and

prove their abilities. "It gives young people self-confidence and it raises their self-esteem," he said. "It gives them the belief that they can work as part of a team in a workplace."

Midland Brick general manager Peter Hogan said the partnership suited the business because it allowed

it to channel its community work through a single relationship.

"We are good at making bricks, but we are not good at running social development programs for disadvantaged people," he said.

Mr Henderson said he had gained communication, organisation and

housekeeping skills during his time working at the company.

He has carried out brick cutting and other general duties at the Middle Swan premises for more than a year.

"It gives you a lot of opportunities, you meet new friends and learn about the place," Mr Henderson said.

A TEST which could help save victims of asbestos-related cancer mesothelioma is among WA medical research projects awarded more than \$14 million Federal aid.

Developed by University of Victorian scientist Brian Robinson, the project aims to allow early diagnosis and treatment.

Researchers believe early signs can be detected from mesothelin protein the cancer produces, in blood.

The project has been allocated \$307,000 over the next three years.

Federal Health Minister Kay Lister welcomed the possibility of a breakthrough in early detection.

University of WA research dominated the successful WA applicants for funding from the National Health and Medical Research Council, which allocated \$150 million to 406 projects nationally
